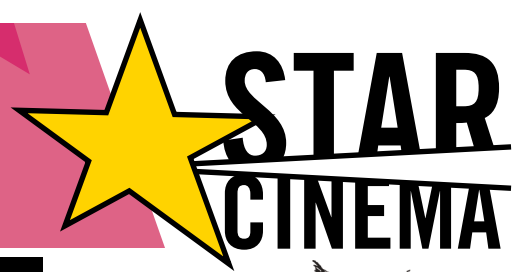

A shy butler who keeps to himself, Albert has been hiding a deep secret for some thirty years - 'he' is a woman who has had to dress and behave as a man in order to escape a life of poverty and loneliness. 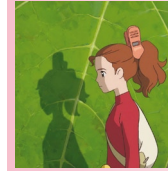
WE NEED TO TALK ABOUT KEVIN (MA) 111min

ARRIETTY (G) 94min



14-year-old Arrietty and her family are a race of 'tiny people' who live in peaceful anonymity under the floorboards and make their own home from items 'borrowed' from the house's human inhabitants. When a human boy named Sho stumbles upon Arrietty, the inevitable risk of human interference begins to endanger their lives. From the creators of *Spirited Away* and *Ponyo* and based on Mary Norton's beloved children's novel *The Borrowers*, this is a magical piece of storytelling that's a treat for both adults and children alike. *Dir Hiromasa Yonebayashi, Japan. THE DESCENDANTS (M) 115min



From the creator of *Sideways* comes this sometimes humorous, sometimes tragic journey set in Hawaii. As he attempts to repair his relationship with his daughters, he discovers his wife was having an affair. With his girls in tow, Matt embarks on a search for his wife's lover, leading to a tumultuous awakening that changes his concept of love, fatherhood and what it truly takes to be a man. *Dir Alexander Payne, USA. A FEW BEST MEN (MA) 97min



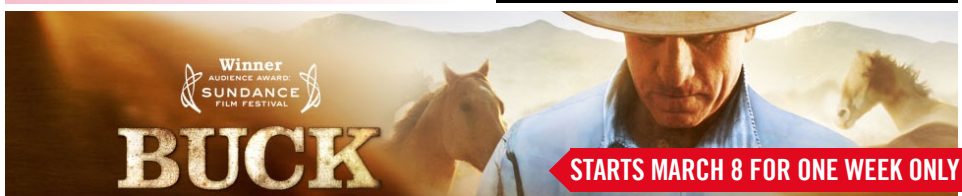

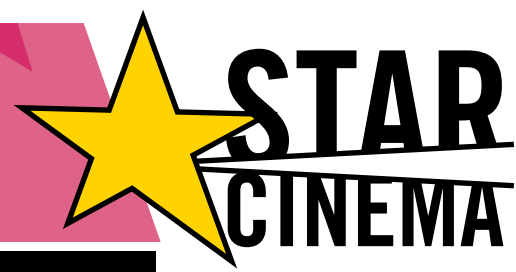

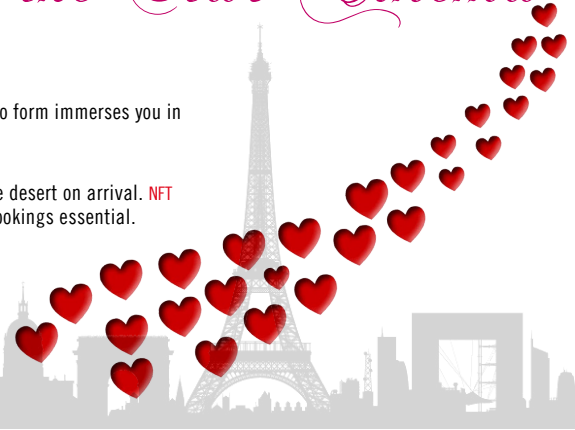
